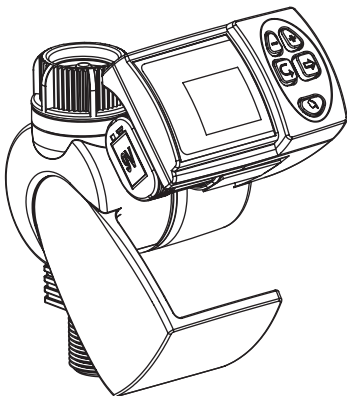

Pareamento do smartphone com os controladores Galcon

O pareamento é necessário apenas uma vez. Após o pareamento inicial, o aplicativo se sincroniza automaticamente com o controlador.

Siga estes passos para parear seu smartphone: insira as baterias apropriadas no controlador. Para instruções detalhadas, veja seu guia do usuário do controlador.

1. Baixe e instale o aplicativo Galcon BT das lojas ou escaneando o código de barras.
2. Se o aplicativo requer que você ligue o Bluetooth, digite OK para confirmar*. Uma tela de boas-vindas é apresentada.

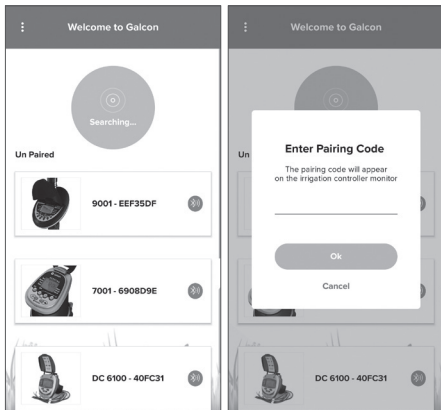

3. Em unpaired timers [temporizadores não pareados], clique no nome do modelo do seu controlador. Se nenhum controlador for exibido, clique em Scan for timers [Procurar por temporizadores].
4. No controlador, é apresentado o ícone Bluetooth, seguido de um código de 4 dígitos.
5. Digite o código de pareamento e clique OK. Quando o pareamento estiver completado, o telefone e o controlador estarão conectados, e a tela do aplicativo será apresentada.




Solução de problemas

Verifique as seguintes opções:




- Certifique-se que você dá permissão para "Location Services" ao instalar o aplicativo
- Certifique-se que "Location Services" está ligado
- Vá para as opções do Bluetooth no telefone e certifique-se que o controlador está na lista dos aparelhos
 - **Se o controlador não aparece na lista, reinicie o controlador**
 - If the controller appears in the list, turn off and turn on Bluetooth on the phone
- Se o controlador está na lista, desligue e ligue o Bluetooth no telefone
- **Se o controlador aparece no aplicativo mas não pode se conectar**, tente conectar com outro telefone para identificar o problema

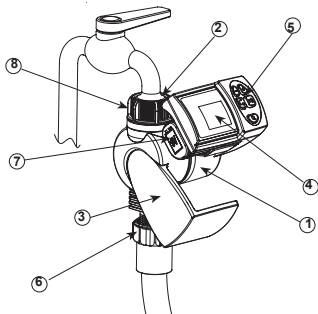

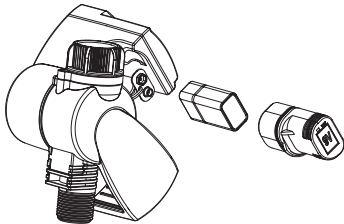
1. Corpo do controlador.

2. INSTALAÇÃO DA BATERIA

1. Com a tela do controlador posicionada de frente para você, remova a tampa do compartimento de bateria.
2. Insira a bateria de 9V no compartimento.
3. Feche o compartimento de bateria com a tampa.
4. Atenção: ao trocar a bateria, assegure-se de que o compartimento de bateria esteja seco.

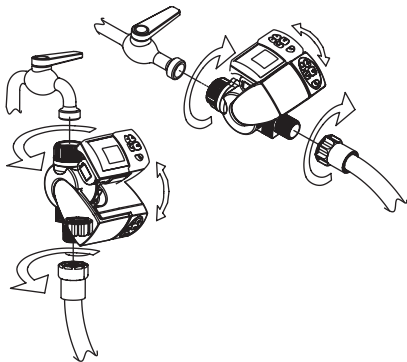
Utilize apenas baterias alcalinas.



3. INSTALAÇÃO DO CONTROLADOR

4

1. Assegure-se de que o filtro esteja em seu lugar.
2. Depois, para conectar o controlador, encaixe o adaptador feminino de mangueira na torneira e gire no sentido horário, apenas com as mãos, sem utilizar ferramentas.
3. Em seguida, encaixe o conector masculino em seu sistema de irrigação.



4. PROGRAMAÇÃO DE IRRIGAÇÃO


Esta seção contém um exemplo de irrigação semanal. Você pode alterar as datas exemplificadas e adaptar a programação à sua necessidade.

O controlador digital é programado com o auxílio de 4 botões:

- ⓐ Tecla 'fase de programação' - utilizada para selecionar o modo de programação desejado (por exemplo, por duração de irrigação).
- ➡ Tecla de seleção - utilizada para selecionar as opções que serão modificadas (como hora, minuto etc). Para fazer a alteração, a opção selecionada deve estar piscando na tela.
- ⊕ Tecla 'aumentar' - aumenta o número da opção selecionada (por exemplo, aumenta uma hora).
- ⊖ Tecla 'diminuir' - diminui o número da opção selecionada (por exemplo, reduz uma hora).

Se não é feito nenhum ajuste de programação, a tela do controlador sempre retorna para a tela principal (relógio).

Os dígitos na tela irão parar de piscar depois de 40 segundos.

Se a opção de ajuste selecionada parar de piscar antes de você terminar a programação, aperte a tecla  para continuar o processo.






Irrigação de emergência: Depois de inserida a bateria, caso nenhum botão seja pressionado, o relógio na tela irá piscar continuamente.

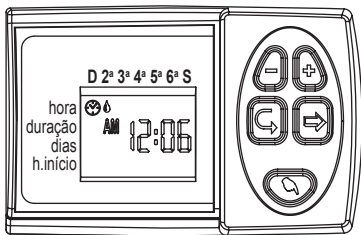
Depois de 10 minutos, o controlador irá implementar uma irrigação de 5 minutos em um ciclo de 24 horas.




AJUSTE DE HORA E DIA DA SEMANA

Ajuste do relógio

Para programar a irrigação nos dias e horários necessários, é preciso ajustar o relógio da seguinte forma:

1. Aperte a tecla  até que apareça o ícone .
 2. Aperte a tecla . Os dígitos das horas irão piscar. Ajuste os dígitos correspondentes à hora com os botões  e .



3. Aperte a tecla . Os dígitos dos minutos irão piscar. Ajuste os minutos com o auxílio dos botões  e .

Ajuste do dia da semana

1. Pressione a tecla ⊖ até que apareça uma gotinha piscando no topo da tela.
2. Posicione a gotinha no dia escolhido utilizando as teclas ⊕ ou ⊖.

Para um relógio 24 horas, pressione ao mesmo tempo as teclas e até que os dígitos de hora e minuto parem de piscar. Caso queira voltar para ⊕ o ⊖ sistema AM/PM, pressione novamente os mesmos botões.

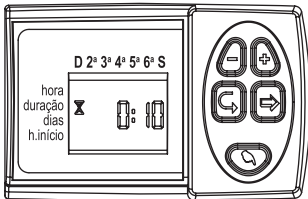
PROGRAMANDO UMA IRRIGAÇÃO SEMANAL

Vamos utilizar como exemplo uma programação de irrigação de 10 minutos de duração, em três horários (às 8AM, às 1PM e às 7PM), nas terças e sextas-feiras.









PROGRAMANDO DURAÇÃO DA IRRIGAÇÃO

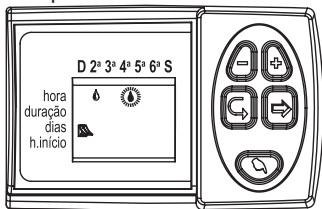
1. Aperte \ominus até que apareça o símbolo Σ ao lado de 'Duração'. O dígito de hora (0) irá piscar.
2. Aperte \oplus ou \ominus para alterar a duração da irrigação.

Atenção: Depois dos primeiros 15 minutos, a duração será programada para intervalos de 15 minutos.











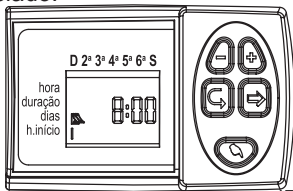
PROGRAMANDO OS DIAS DE IRRIGAÇÃO

1. Aperte . O símbolo  aparecerá ao lado da palavra 'Dias'. Se você estiver programando o controlador pela primeira vez, a palavra OFF irá piscar na tela.
2. Aperte . Uma gotinha () aparecerá embaixo da palavra 'domingo', na parte superior da tela. Utilize a tecla  para mover e posicionar a gotinha piscante embaixo do dia escolhido (no caso, terça-feira) e aperte a tecla . A gotinha embaixo de 'terça-feira' irá parar de piscar. Outra gotinha começará a piscar embaixo do dia seguinte (no caso, quarta-feira). Utilize a tecla  para mover a segunda gotinha até o segundo dia de irrigação escolhido, sexta-feira. Aperte novamente a tecla .



DEFININDO A HORA E DIA DO INÍCIO DA IRRIGAÇÃO




1. Aperte a tecla . A palavra START aparecerá na tela. Aperte a tecla . Os dígitos da hora começarão a piscar.
2. Utilizando as teclas  ou , ajuste a hora de início para 8AM (repare nos indicadores AM/PM). Repita essa operação para programar a segunda irrigação (START II) para a 1PM, e a terceira irrigação (START III) para as 7PM.
3. Aperte a tecla . A palavra START IV aparecerá na tela. Aperte a tecla . Os dígitos da hora começarão a piscar.
4. Aperte as teclas  ou  até que a palavra OFF apareça na tela. Assim, o início da quarta irrigação será cancelado.

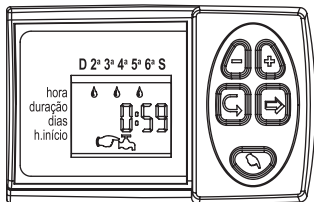


OPERAÇÃO MANUAL COMPUTADORIZADA


Esta opção gerencia a válvula para o período de irrigação definido. A válvula será fechada automaticamente no final de cada irrigação. Observe que a programação original de irrigação continuará a funcionar nos períodos definidos.

Essa definição não pode ser implementada quando a tela está piscando.

Ativação: aperte a tecla . O ícone  aparecerá ao lado da palavra 'Manual', e o ícone  aparecerá embaixo da mesma.



AVISO DE POUCA BATERIA

Quando a bateria estiver no final, o seguinte ícone começará a piscar: . Nesse momento, ainda restará uma quantidade de energia suficiente para uma operação com a válvula. Mas deve ser feita a troca da bateria o quanto antes.

Se a bateria não for substituída, o controlador fará ainda mais oito irrigações e depois irá parar de funcionar. A palavra "OFF" aparecerá na tela.

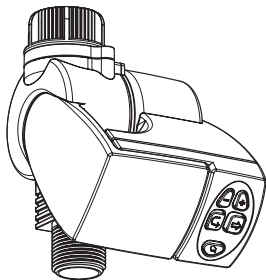
A programação de irrigação definida não será perdida caso a troca de bateria seja feita dentro de 30 segundos.

IRRIGAÇÃO NÃO DEFINIDA

Caso não sejam definidos os dias de irrigação, a palavra noPr aparecerá na tela (ver Programando uma Irrigação Semanal). Nesse caso, a válvula não pode ser aberta durante a operação manual computadorizada (ver Operação Manual Computadorizada).

5. MANUTENÇÃO

Remova as baterias caso o controlador não vá ser utilizado por um longo período. Remova e limpe o filtro interno de tempos em tempos. Se o filtro não for limpo de forma regular, poderá causar problemas ao controlador. Em condições normais de uso, a bateria deve durar, no mínimo, um ano.

LIMITED WARRANTY CERTIFICATE AND TERMS OF SERVICE FOR "GALCON SMART PRODUCTS (GSI, CYBER RAIN, 7101BT, 9001BT, 11000BT)"

1. Galcon sells the "Galcon Smart" irrigation controllers ("the products") and provide associated product software in means of browser based software and/or mobile application software and/or client based software and/or any other software that provided with the product ("the Product Software") and certain services ("the Services") through Galcon's Web Site (www.galconc.com) and/or through any mobile phone and devices application download center and/or through self-installation software ("the Site"). This Limited Warranty Certificate and Terms of service ("these Terms") constitute a legal agreement between Galcon and the original purchaser of the Product ("the Customer"), and shall govern the Customer's access and use of the Services and the Product. By accessing the Site and/or by using the Services and/or the Product, the Customer agrees that he has read, understood, accept and agree to be bound by these Terms. If the Customer does not agree with any of the provisions of these Terms, the Customer must not access or use the Services and/or the Product.
2. Galcon shall, for a limited period of 36 months from the retail purchase date of the original (first) purchaser ("the Warranty Period"), provide limited warranty for the Product(s) and the Services, as provided for and subject to the provisions and limitations of these Terms. Without derogating from the foregoing, Galcon does not take any obligation to provide the Services (or any part therefrom) beyond the Warranty Period.
3. Galcon's Warranty for the Product and/or the Services only extends to the Customer who, upon requesting warranty service, must present Galcon with a valid and duly signed contract with Galcon (or any of its authorized dealers) together with a valid purchase receipt. Failure to produce the said documentation will result in the request for warranty being null and void.
4. Galcon warrants to the Customer that the Product shall materially conform to the description in Galcon's documentation and shall be free from defects in material and workmanship. Accordingly, Customer's sole and exclusive remedy under this warranty is the repair or – to Galcon's sole discretion – the replacement of the Product or any parts according to the terms of this Warranty, and no other remedy shall be available. Therefore, if - within the Warranty Period - the Product is proven to be defective by reason of faulty workmanship or materials by Galcon, Galcon undertakes, with reasonable promptness, to have the defective Product (or any part/s thereof) repaired, or at Galcon's discretion, replaced; All subject to the terms and conditions of these Terms.

5. Galcon does not give any warranty or guarantee whatsoever in respect of any Product or Services (or any part/s thereof) which has not been manufactured and distributed by Galcon and which has not been purchased from Galcon or any of its authorized dealers, whether such products are branded with any trademarks similar to any trademark belonging to or used by Galcon.
 9. After replacement or repair of the Product, the Warranty for the new or repaired Product shall be valid only for the non-expired period of the original Warranty Period. Any defective Products or part/s, which has been replaced, shall become Galcon's property.
 10. Galcon reserves the right to charge the Customer if any warranty service is requested and carried out but no fault is found in the Product or if such defect/fault is not under Galcon's Warranty.
 11. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, Galcon shall not be responsible and/or liable, under any circumstances and in any way, for any loss, damage, costs, expenses, expenditures, responsibility and/or liability (including of Customer and/or any third party) – including (without limitation) direct and/or indirect (including incidental and/or special and/or consequential), however arising, including in respect of damages to or loss of property and/or equipment, loss of profit, loss of use, loss of revenue or damages to business or reputation, whether or not based on breach of contract, tort (including negligence), product liability or otherwise - arising from the performance or non-performance of any aspect of the Services and/or the Product and/or access to Site or any part thereof; All of the above, whether or not Galcon and/or the Customer shall have been made aware of the possibility of such loss.
